

**SCHOOL BUS EXPECTATIONS**  
**BE SAFE**  
**BE RESPECTFUL**  
**BE RESPONSIBLE**

Students are expected to:

- Remain seated at all times.
- Be courteous.
- Face forward at all times.
- Refrain from fighting, wrestling or boisterous activity.
- Wear seatbelts.
- Refrain from eating and drinking on the school bus.
- Refrain from using pencils or pens on the school bus.
- Use inside voices.
- Keep hands to oneself.
- Use the emergency door only in case of emergency.
- Cross only in front of the bus as instructed by the bus driver.
- Stand **only** at designated bus stops.
- Provide a bus pass from their school office if riding a bus other than their designated bus.

Bus drivers are expected to:

- Speak respectfully to students.
- Remind students of expectations.
- Report bus incidents through the use of bus referral forms – include date and time of incident and submit referrals in a timely manner – one date and one incident per form.
- Address student issues immediately.
- Slow down when entering and exiting school properties.
- Follow the bus route as written.
- Assign seats as necessary in coordination with the building principal.

Students are allowed to:

- Speak quietly to one another.
- Read books.
- Change seats only with bus driver permission.
